LEADING RIDER BONUSES

At Northcote, we want to provide opportunities for success, no matter what level you ride at. To honour this ethos, we have introduced three leading rider bonuses at our major events.

GOLD

£500

Points can be earned during eligible competitions that are over 1.20m

SILVER

£250

Points can be earned during eligible competitions between 1.10m and 1.20m

BRONZE

£100

Points can be earned during eligible competitions that are under 1.10m.

POINT INFORMATION

Points will be awarded to the top 15 in each eligible competition. This will be on a sliding scale with the winner achieving 15 points. Please see the class wording in the official British Showjumping schedule (attached) to check which competitions are eligible for each rider bonus. Points also awarded during Friday 9th's unaffiliated day.

Class 9a - Andrews Bowen Outdoor - Equissage Pulse Senior British Novice First Round

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm. DRAWN ORDER

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members

a) For horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2017 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the British Novice Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6.

Qualifies for: Senior British Novice Championship - Second Round.

Qualifying period: 1st May - 30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in the British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be

determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification.

If combined with an open:

In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the British Novice section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

A £50 bonus will be paid to the highest placed 4yo. This will be based on the results of both 9a and 9b with one bonus being awarded. Points from this competition will count towards the Bronze Leading Rider award. Additional points will be available during Friday's Unaffiliated and also Saturday/Sunday's British Showjumping competitions.

Prizes: 1st: £35.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £22.00, 4th: £20.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £122.00. Entry Fee = £20.00

Class 9b - Andrews Bowen Outdoor - **Senior 90cm Open**

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

A £50 bonus will be paid to the highest placed 4yo. This will be based on the results of both 9a and 9b with one bonus being awarded. Points from this competition will count towards the Bronze Leading Rider award. Additional points will be available during Friday's Unaffiliated and also Saturday/Sunday's British Showjumping competitions.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

a) For horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2016 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round.

Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the Senior Discovery Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification.

If combined with an open:

In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

A £50 bonus will be paid to the highest placed 5yo. This will be based on the results of both 10a and 10b with one bonus being awarded. Points from this competition will count towards the Bronze Leading Rider award. Additional points will be available during Friday's Unaffiliated and also Saturday/Sunday's British Showjumping competitions.

Points from this competition will count towards the Bronze Leading Rider award. For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Points from this competition will count towards the Bronze Leading Rider award. Additional points are available during Friday's unaffiliated competitions and Saturday/Sunday's British Showjumping competitions.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- Newcomers:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6

(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2014, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6.

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period: The Senior Newcomers Second Round qualifying period for 2019/2020 (2020 second rounds and finals) is 1 June - 31 May inclusive. The Senior Newcomers Second Round qualifying period for 2020/2021 (2021 second rounds and finals) is 1 May – 30 April (subject to revision).

If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

- 1.10m Open:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

A £50 bonus will be paid to the highest placed 6yo. This will be based on the results of both 12a and 12b with one bonus being awarded. Points from this competition will count towards the Silver Leading Rider award. Additional points will be available during Friday's Unaffiliated and also Saturday/Sunday's British Showjumping competitions.

Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £22.00, 5th: £22.00, Total: £139.00. Entry Fee = £22.00

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop GLME In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes will be withheld. Rule - 76.6

- Foxhunter:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2014, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round qualifying period for 2021 second rounds and finals is 1 May '20 – 30 April '21 (subject to revision).

Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2020 are not eligible for qualification to the 2021 Championship.

If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

- 1.20m Open:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

A £50 bonus will be paid to the highest placed 7yo. This will be based on the results of both 13a and 13b with one bonus being awarded. Points from this competition will count towards the Silver Leading Rider award. Additional points will be available during Friday's Unaffiliated and also Saturday/Sunday's British Showjumping competitions.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £25.00, 5th: £25.00, Total: £160.00. Entry Fee = £25.00

Qualifies for: The British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualifying period: 1st July-30th June.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round))

- National 1.40m Open:

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Qualifies for: National 1.40m Championship at the British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualifying period: 1st July - 30th June.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify to the final. Also any two double clears from any International Trial or Area Trial or classes 1.40m or above in the qualifying period will qualify for the Final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from one round competitions (e.g. Table A4 or Table A (1 Round))
